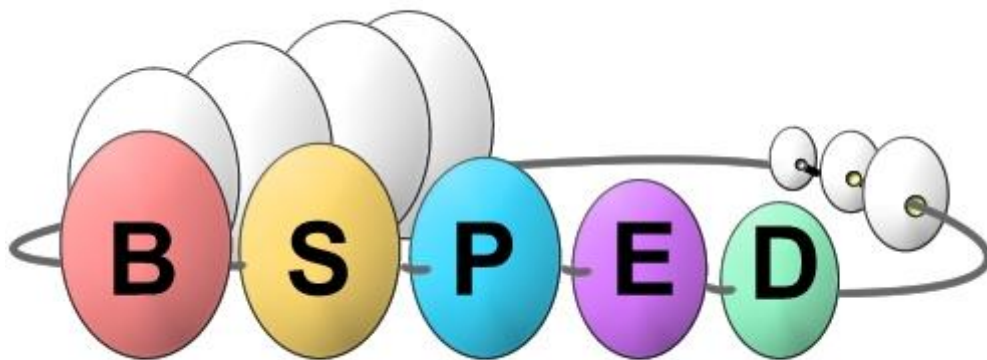

To apply

Applicants must be proposed and seconded by current members of the BSPED. Members will be officially accepted by the Executive Committee who meet quarterly.

Membership subscriptions are collected annually and payment for the first year is required upon application. The subscription year runs from 1 August to 31 July.

Non-consultant grade applicants in training posts wishing to apply for the reduced rate are required to provide the signature of their head of department.

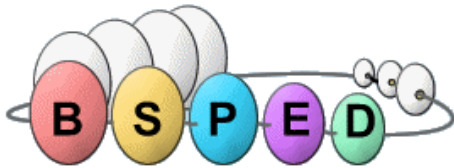
