# BSPED Membership Career Stage 2025












# BSPED Annual Meeting



# BSPED 2026, Bristol Beacon, 8-10 December





- The BSPED Annual Meeting takes place in Q4 each year.
- The meeting attracts around 500-600 specialist attendees, the majority of whom are clinical practitioners.
- The programme runs over three days with a combination of plenary sessions, dedicated endocrine and diabetes parallel sessions and posters. Day 1 is dedicated to our younger professionals and offers a tailored programme given by experts.
- The industry exhibition will be open on all 3 days. Breaks will provide opportunities for networking with the delegates.
- There is the potential to run sponsored symposia and/or training sessions depending on your requirements.



Situated in the heart of Bristol city centre, the Beacon has recently been transformed into a state-of-the-art facility. Fully accessible, sustainable and has welcomed many artists over the years. 


