

## Current studies/ interests underway include

- 1. USTEKID-Phase II multi-centre, double-blind, randomised trial of Ustekinumab in adolescents with new-onset Type 1 Diabetes
- 2. PROTECT- Provention Bio's T1D Trial Evaluating C -Peptide with Teplizumab
- 3. The TED study-Developing a predictive Tool using data linkage and machine learning, to promote Earlier Diagnosis of Type 1 diabetes in childhood for use in primary care
- 4. The Circuit study looking at T cell responses in newly diagnosed CYP with type 1 diabetes.

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
